Are you interested in gaining academic publishing experience? Do you want to boost your academic CV and further develop your academic network? Would you like to publish your BA/MA thesis or a great paper from one of your courses?

KLEOS cordially invites enthusiastic starting researchers – including BA/MA and PhD students – from the fields of Ancient Studies and Archaeology to submit a paper to KLEOS – the Amsterdam Bulletin of Ancient Studies and Archaeology!

WHAT IS KLEOS?

KLEOS is a peer-reviewed, open access academic journal, launched in 2014, which publishes current research and review articles by graduate and PhD students as well as starting independent researchers from the fields of Archaeology and Ancient Studies. The journal is published once a year and its main goal is to provide a possibility to graduate and PhD students to publish their research.

WHAT DOES KLEOS PUBLISH?

KLEOS publishes several types of papers:

- Research or theoretical papers: ca. 3000-4000 words (regular papers) or 2000-2500 (short papers).
- Dialogue papers: a paper of ca. 4000-6000 words and written by at least 2 authors.
- **Book Reviews**: ca. 750-1500 words (not peer-reviewed).
- Letters to the editors/editorial: ca. 400-800 words (not peer-reviewed).

WHAT KLEOS OFFERS CONTRIBUTORS!

KLEOS offers contributors **extensive editorial support** in the preparation of their article for publication. This consist not only of constructive feedback by an experienced interdisciplinary editorial team, but also by **expert peer reviewers**, who are all vested academic scholars in their field of study.

KLEOS furthermore aspires to provide contributors with a platform for extending their academic network and the possibility to increase their academic visibility. As such, contributors will be asked to provide information on themselves and their research, which will be used for promotion on the digital platforms and through the digital networks of Kleos.

HOW TO SUBMIT?

If you wish to submit a paper or review please send a short abstract (no longer than 300 words) before Monday 30th of April 2018. Please include the following information in your submission mail:

- Provisional title
- Author information
- Word count

If your abstract is accepted you will be expected to hand in a first draft for editorial review Friday 20th of June 2018.
